## DURING AN INSPECTION OF YOUR FIRM WE OBSERVED:

## **OBSERVATION 1**

Failure to perform microbial testing where necessary to identify possible food contamination.

Specifically,

You stated the results of your sampling for environmental pathogens on non-food contact surfaces as defined in your written procedure entitled "Plant Environmental Testing" were used as an indicator in determining whether the cleaning and sanitization program was effective. However, this sampling program failed to include the following:

- a. Sampling of food contact surfaces
- b. Determination of any preventive action needed in response to the possible contamination.
- c. Determination of the impact on the products produced on the affected date.
- d. Determination of the Listeria spp. associated with the presumptive positive results.

## **OBSERVATION 2**

Suitable outer garments are not worn that protect against contamination of food and food contact surfaces.

Specifically on 4/20/2015,

An employee's shirt came into direct contact with the interior liner of an ingredient container while the employee was loading the ingredients into Fruit Feeder # (b) on the (b) (d) line during production of Bride's Cake Ice Cream. The employee, who was not dressed in the appropriate Blue Bell outer garment, was wearing a shirt which appeared soiled and with several holes
